

ORDINANCE NO. 106 N.S.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DOES
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. No minor under the age of Seventeen years, shall be in or upon the streets or other public thoroughfares in the city of El Paso de Robles, between the hours of 9 P.M. and 6 A.M.; provided, however, that a minor under the age of Seventeen years may be upon the streets of the City between the hours of 9 P.M. and 6 A.M. pursuant to the scope of his lawful employment and such employment has been registered and approved by the Police Department of the city of El Paso de Robles. Provided, further, that a minor under the age of Seventeen years may be in or upon the streets of the City of El Paso de Robles, between the hours of 9 P.M. and 6 A.M. when such minor is in the company of his parents or legal guardian, or person or persons having legal care, custody and control of such minor, or when such minor is en route home by the most direct route from an otherwise lawful public or private gathering or meeting.

SECTION 2. No parent, guardian, or other person or persons entitled to the care, custody and control of any minor under the age of Seventeen years, shall permit such minor to be in or upon the streets or other public place in the city of El Paso de Robles between the hours of 9 P.M. and 6 A.M., except as aforesaid.

SECTION 3. Any person violating Section 1 of this ordinance shall be taken into the custody of the Police Department of the city of El Paso de Robles, and then placed under the custody and control of the Juvenile Court of San Luis Obispo County, and subject to the jurisdiction and control of said Superior Court.

SECTION 4. Any person violating Section 2 of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), or by imprisonment in the County

Jail not exceeding thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.




