

ORDINANCE NO. 115 N.S.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TRAFFIC ORDINANCE #44 N.S.

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does ordain as follows:

SECTION I.


That Section 27 of Ordinance #44 N. S. entitled, "An Ordinance Regulating Traffic upon the Public Streets and Repealing all Ordinances Inconsistent Herewith", passed on the 26th day of November, 1930, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto a new Section to be numbered 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ , reading as follows:

SECTION 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ . It shall be unlawful for the operator of a vehicle to stop said vehicle for a period of time longer than ten (10) minutes in any of the following places:

- (1) On the south side of 12th Street, between Vine and Spring Streets and fronting the United States Post Office.

Every such limited zone shall be designated by green paint upon the entire curb surface with the words "10 MINUTE PARKING", painted in white letters thereon.


