

ORDINANCE NO. 139 N.S.

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE, INSTALLATION AND INSPECTION OF ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 63 NS., ORDINANCE 67 N.S., AND ORDINANCE 73 N.S.

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does ordain as follows:


SECTION 1. That a certain document, three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles, each being marked and designated as the "Uniform Electrical Code, Published by the Pacific Coast Electrical Bureau, 1947 Edition," and as it may be amended or revised from time to time, be and the same is hereby adopted as the Electrical Code of the City of El Paso de Robles for the regulation, sale, inspection and installation of electrical equipment and the doing of electrical wiring within the City of El Paso de Robles.

SECTION 2. No person, firm or corporation shall engage in such business of contracting for the installation, alteration, or repair, nor shall they engage in the business of installing, altering or repairing, any electrical devices or electrical wiring within this City without first having executed and deposited with the City Clerk of this City a corporate surety bond payable to said City in the penal sum of Five Hundred (500) Dollars signed by the principal and a corporate surety authorized to do business in the State of California. The condition of said bond shall be as follows: The condition of this obligation is such that if the said Principal shall faithfully abide by and faithfully perform all work in accordance with the provisions of the ordinances of the City of El Paso de Robles, and shall, upon fifteen (15) days notice from the City Inspector of the City of El Paso de Robles, remedy any defect, without charge, caused by the installation of

faulty, unapproved or defective materials used by the said Principal, and shall indemnify and save harmless the City of El Paso de Robles and any person, or persons, who may be injured or damaged through any failure on the part of said Principal to comply with the ordinances of the City of El Paso de Robles, then this obligation shall be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That Ordinance No. 63 N.S., entitled "An Ordinance Regulating the Sale, Installation and Inspection of Electrical Equipment," passed on the 18th day of October, 1937 and Ordinances 67 N.S. and 73 N.S. amending said Ordinance No. 63 N.S. and all other Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


