... the annexation of the uninhabited territory particular-  
... described as follows:

All of Tract 38, Arbor Villa  
Subdivision, of the County of Cali-  
fornia, as recorded in the Office  
of the County Recorder of said  
County and State, including those  
two parcels of land located with-  
in the territorial limits of said  
subdivision, but which parcels  
did not form a portion of said  
Subdivision, and containing 15  
acres.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City of El  
Paso de Robles has heretofore recommended the annexation of said  
uninhabited territory to the City of El Paso de Robles; and  
WHEREAS, this City Council has, by Resolution No. 900,  
dated November 15, 1954, fixed the 20th day of December, 1954, at  
the hour of Eight o'clock P. M. of said date, at the Council Chamber  
in the City Hall, in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San  
Luis Obispo, State of California, as the time and place when and  
where any person owning real property within said territory  
so proposed to be annexed and having any objection to the proposed  
annexation might appear before the City Council and show cause why  
such territory should not be so annexed or might file written protest  
against the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles is acting upon said petition for annexation under  
visions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California  
entitled "Annexation of Uninhabited Territory"  
also known as Title 4, Division 2, Part 1, Chapter 1, of  
the Government Code of the State of California;

WHEREAS, the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles has caused a copy of said Resolution to be published for the time, in the form and manner as required by law, as appears from the affidavit of publication of said Resolution on file with the City Clerk of said City; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles caused written notice of time and place of hearing protests of said annexation to be mailed to all owners of real property lying within said territory, and said notice was mailed in the time, form and manner as required by the Government Code, as amended, as appears from the affidavit of mailing of said notice on file with the City Clerk of said City; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been had on said proposed annexation as so noticed, and no protest or objection having been made to said proposed annexation by any owner of property within the territory proposed to be annexed, by the filing of a written protest or otherwise; and

WHEREAS, the written consent of all the owners of all the property described in "Annexation No. Four" has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles on April 1, 1955, consenting that all of said property may be taxed to pay any indebtedness or liability of the City contracted prior to or existing at the time of annexation;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That said City Council does hereby approve the annexation to the City of El Paso de Robles as "Annexation No. Four" of the uninhabited territory contiguous to the City of El Paso de Robles, situate in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, and described as follows:

All of tract 38, Arbor Villa  
Subdivision, of the County of  
San Luis Obispo, State of Cali-  
fornia, as recorded in the Office  
of the County Recorder of said  
County and State, including those  
two parcels of land located with-

in the territorial limits of said subdivision, but which parcels did not form a portion of said subdivision, and containing 15 acres.

SECTION 2: That all of the property described in Section 1 above may be taxed to pay any indebtedness or liability of the City of El Paso de Robles contracted prior to or existing at the time this Ordinance of Annexation becomes effective.

SECTION 3: That the City Clerk of this City, being the Ex-Officio Clerk of this City Council, promptly upon this Ordinance becoming effective, prepare under the Seal of the City of El Paso de Robles, a certified copy of this Ordinance, giving the date of its passage, and transmit it to the Secretary of State.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the City of El Paso de Robles this 18th day of April, 1955.


