

ORDINANCE NO. 193 N.S.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN CONTIGUOUS
UNINHABITED TERRITORY OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE
ROBLES AS "ANNEXATION NUMBER FIVE".

WHEREAS, a petition has heretofore been filed with the City of El Paso de Robles on the 11th day of July, 1955, requesting the annexation of the uninhabited territory particularly described as follows:

All of Villa Lot 39, according to the Map of the City of El Paso de Robles and adjacent lands filed for record October 25, 1889 in the Office of the San Luis Obispo County Recorder.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City of El Paso de Robles has heretofore recommended the annexation of said uninhabited territory to the City of El Paso de Robles; and

WHEREAS, this City Council has, by Resolution No. 920, dated July 18, 1955, fixed the 22nd day of August, 1955, at the hour of Eight o'clock P. M. of said date, at the Council Chamber in the City Hall, in the City of El Paso de Robles, County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, as the time and place when and where any person owning real property within which said territory so proposed to be annexed and having any objection to the proposed annexation might appear before the City Council and show cause why such territory should not be so annexed and having any objection to the proposed annexation might appear before the City Council and show cause why such territory should not be so annexed or might file written protest against the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles is acting upon said petition for annexation under the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California entitled "Annexation of Uninhabited Territory Act of 1939, as Amended", also known as Title 4, Division 2, Part 2, Chapter 1, Article 5 of the Government Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles has caused a copy of said Resolution to be published for the time, in the form and manner as required by law, as appears from the affidavit of publication of said Resolution on file with the City Clerk of said City; and has caused copies of said Resolution to be posted in the manner and for the time as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk of the City of El Paso de Robles caused written notice of time and place of hearing protests of said annexation to be mailed to all owners of real property lying within said territory, and said notice was mailed in the time, form and manner as required by the Government Code, as amended, as appears from the affidavit of mailing of said notice on file with the City Clerk of said City; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been had on said proposed annexation as so noticed, and no protest or objection having been made to said proposed annexation by any owner of property within the territory proposed to be annexed, by the filing of a written protest or otherwise; and

WHEREAS, the written consent of all the owners of all the property described in Annexation Number Five consenting that all of said property should be subject to the same tax rate as that within the City of El Paso de Robles and that said land be subject to all outstanding obligations of said City, including outstanding bond indebtedness, and that such written consent was incorporated in the Petition to the City to annex said uninhabited territory;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That said City Council does hereby approve the annexation to the City of El Paso de Robles as "Annexation Number Five" of the uninhabited territory contiguous to the City of

El Paso de Robles, situate in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, and described as follows:


All of Villa Lot 39, according to the Map of the City of El Paso de Robles and adjacent lands filed for record October 25, 1889 in the Office of the San Luis Obispo County Recorder.

SECTION 2: That all of the property described in Section 1 above may be taxed to pay any indebtedness or liability of the City of El Paso de Robles contracted prior to or existing at the time this Ordinance of Annexation becomes effective.

SECTION 3: That the City Clerk of this City, being the Ex-Officio Clerk of this City Council, promptly upon this Ordinance becoming effective, prepare under the Seal of the City of El Paso de Robles, a certified copy of this Ordinance, giving the date of its passage, and transmit it to the Secretary of State.
