

ORDINANCE NO. 221 N. S.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 16th DAY OF JUNE, 1959, PERTAINING TO THE "ANNEXATION NO. 8" -- CAPITOL HILL AND ADJOINING LANDS.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 1096, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles declared its intention to call a special election to be held on the 12th day of May, 1959, in certain inhabited territory contiguous to said city proposed to be annexed to said city, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors residing in said territory the question whether or not said territory shall be annexed to said city; and

WHEREAS, a copy of said resolution was published as required by law; and

WHEREAS, at a time not later than the hour set by said resolution for hearing objections to the proposed election no written or oral protests were made by the owners of a majority of separate parcels of property within the territory proposed to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the meeting of March 16, 1959, was continued until 8 o'clock p. m. on April 6, 1959, for the purpose of determining the percentage of protest to said annexation, and the City Council finding that there are not written or oral protests made by the owners of One-Half the value of the territory proposed to be annexed as shown by the last equalized assessment roll, and that the protests are not made by public and private owners equal to One-Half of the value territory as shown on the assessment roll; and

WHEREAS, all proceedings have been had in accordance with said resolution and the Annexation Act of 1913, reference thereto hereby being made for further particulars;

In all particulars not herein recited said election
shall be held in conformity, as near as may be, with the laws
of the State of California concerning general elections and
with said Annexation Act of 1913.

SECTION 4:

(a) For the purpose of said election there here-
by is established in the territory described herein one (1)
voting precinct, which shall include all of said territory.
The following is the polling place of said election precinct
and the following named persons hereby are named officers
of election and shall constitute the board of election for
such election precinct:

SECTION 5:

The City Clerk shall publish a notice of said special election as required by said Annexation Act of 1913, at least once a week for the four (4) weeks prior to the date of the election on June 16, 1959, in the San Luis Obispo Telegram-Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published outside of the City of El Paso de Robles but in the County of San Luis Obispo, California.


SECTION 6:


