

ORDINANCE NO. 281 N.S.

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF SAID CITY A PROPOSITION OF INCURRING A BONDED INDEBTEDNESS OF SAID CITY FOR THE ACQUISITION AND CONSTRUCTION AND COMPLETION OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENTS; DECLARING THE ESTIMATED COST OF SAID MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENTS, THE AMOUNT OF THE PRINCIPAL OF SAID INDEBTEDNESS TO BE INCURRED THEREFOR, AND THE MAXIMUM RATE OF INTEREST TO BE PAID THEREON; FIXING THE DATE OF SAID ELECTION, THE MANNER OF HOLDING THE SAME AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE THEREOF

BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, by resolution passed and adopted at a regular meeting thereof held on June 21, 1965, by the affirmative vote of more than two-thirds of all its members, did determine that the public interest and necessity demand the acquisition, construction and completion of the municipal improvements hereinafter mentioned, that the said municipal improvements are necessary and convenient to carry out the objects, purposes and powers of the City and did further determine that the cost of said proposed municipal improvements will be too great to be paid out of the ordinary annual income and revenue of said City, and that the said indebtedness will require an expenditure of funds greater than the amount allowed for it by the annual tax levy of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, as follows:

1. A special municipal election is hereby called and ordered and will be held in the City of El Paso de Robles on Tuesday, the 26th day of October, 1965, at which election shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the City the question of incurring a bonded indebtedness of said City for the objects and purposes set forth in the following proposition, to wit:

PROPOSITION: "Shall the City of El Paso de Robles incur a bonded indebtedness in the principal amount of Two Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$215,000) in accordance with the provisions of the ordinance calling the election at which this proposition is submitted for the acquisition, construction and completion of municipal improvements comprising the removal of an existing bridge and appurtenances and the acquisition, construction and completion of a new bridge across the Salinas River at 13th Street, in the City of El Paso de Robles, together with the acquisition, construction and completion of bridge approaches, the extensions of and additions to public streets in connection therewith, the construction, reconstruction, relocation and improvement of existing facilities made necessary and affected thereby and the acquisition of all lands and easements necessary therefor?"

2. The estimated cost of the municipal improvements as set forth in the Proposition, including legal and other fees, costs of printing the bonds and other costs and expenses incidental to or connected with the authorization, issuance and sale of the bonds therefor, is the sum of \$315,000, of which amount the County of San Luis Obispo and the City of El Paso de Robles, jointly, will contribute \$100,000 from monies on hand, leaving a balance of \$215,000, which is the amount of the principal of the indebtedness proposed to be incurred.

3. The City Council does hereby submit to the qualified electors at the said special municipal election this ordinance and the proposition set forth in Section 1 hereof. The City Council proposes to issue and sell bonds of the City in the amount of, and for the objects and purposes, specified in the proposition if two-thirds of the qualified electors voting on the proposition vote in favor thereof.

4. If two-thirds of the qualified electors voting on the proposition shall vote in favor thereof, the proposition shall be deemed adopted. Said bonds shall be negotiable in form and of the character known as serial, and shall bear interest at a rate not exceeding six percent (6%) per annum payable semi-annually except that interest for the first year after the date of the bonds may be made payable at the end of said year.

5. The said special municipal election shall be held and conducted, the votes thereof canvassed, the returns thereof made, and result thereof ascertained and determined as herein provided; and in all particulars not prescribed by this ordinance said election shall be held as provided by law for the holding of municipal elections in said City.

6. All persons qualified to vote at municipal elections in said City upon the date of the election herein provided for shall be qualified to vote upon the proposition submitted at said special municipal election.

7. For the purpose of holding and conducting said special municipal election there shall be three (3) consolidated election precincts, consisting of consolidations of County Election Precincts as last established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Luis Obispo for the conduct of State and County elections, their descriptions, the polling places designated therefor and the election officers to conduct said election are as follows:

Consolidated Election Precinct No. A shall include and consist of a consolidation of County Election Precincts designated Paso Robles Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5.

The polling place for said Consolidated Election Precinct and the election officers therefor are as follows:

Consolidated Election Precinct No. B shall include and consist of a consolidation of County Election Precincts designated Paso Robles Nos. 6, 7, 8, 10 and 11.

Consolidated Election Precinct No. C shall include and consist of a consolidation of County Election Precincts designated Paso Robles Nos. 9, 12, 13, 14 and 15.

8. Ballots for the election shall be provided of the form and to the number provided by law. On said ballots, in addition to any other printed matter which may be required by law, two voting squares shall be set off to the right of the proposition submitted at the election as set forth in Section 1 of this ordinance in the manner provided by law, one having the word "YES" printed before it and the other having the word "NO" printed before it.

9. Each voter to vote for the proposition and for incurring the bonded indebtedness shall stamp a cross (X) in the blank space opposite the word "YES" on the ballot to the right of the proposition, and to vote against the proposition and against the incurring of the indebtedness shall stamp a cross (X) in the blank

space opposite the word "NO" on the ballot to the right of the proposition.

10. The polls shall be opened at 7:00 o'clock A.M. of the day of the election and shall be kept open until 7:00 o'clock P.M. of the same day, when the polls shall be closed, except as to voters in line as provided in Section 14436 of the Elections Code.

11. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to contact the County Clerk of San Luis Obispo County for the purpose of procuring necessary rosters and ballot boxes and to procure all supplies necessary for the proper conduct of said election.

12. This ordinance is adopted pursuant to Article 1, comprising Sections 43600 to 43638, inclusive, of Chapter 4, Division 4, Title 4 of the Government Code of the State of California.

13. This ordinance shall be published once a week for two (2) successive weeks in the Paso Robles Press, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published less than six (6) days a week in the City, and such publication shall constitute notice of said election. No other notice of the election hereby called need be given.

14. This ordinance, being an ordinance calling and ordering an election, shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
