

ORDINANCE NO. 288, N.S.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING AND ESTABLISHING CERTAIN STREET GRADES  
IN THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That whereas the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, did on the 3rd day of October, 1966, pass a resolution entitled "A Resolution of Intention to Change and Establish Official Grades of Certain Streets in the City of El Paso de Robles"; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution of Intention did state the name of each of the streets, the grades of which or any portion thereof, was proposed to be changed or established, and did also set forth the grade to be changed or established; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution of Intention was immediately posted conspicuously after passage for two days near the chamber door of said City Council, and was published for two insertions in a newspaper published and circulated in said city and designated by said City Council for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Street Superintendent of said City did thereupon cause to be conspicuously posted along all public streets or portions thereof designated in said Resolution of Intention, where such change or establishment of grade is proposed to be made, notices of the passage of said Resolution of Intention. Said notice was headed "Notice of Change of Grade" in letters of not less than one inch in length, and did in legible characters state the fact of the passage of said Resolution of Intention, its date, the name of the public street, or portion thereof, the grade of which it is proposed to change or establish, and did refer to said Resolution of Intention for further particulars; and

WHEREAS, said Street Superintendent did also cause a notice similar in substance to be published by six insertions in a newspaper published and circulated in said city and designated by the City Council for that purpose.

Section 2. WHEREAS, no protests were filed against said proposed change or establishment of grade, and now, therefore, it is ordered that the grades on the streets and portions of streets hereinafter designated be and the same are hereby established at the following elevations, to-wit:

West side of Olive Street:

At North line of 8th Street, 775.10;

120 feet Northerly from 8th Street, 776.20 a point of beginning of a vertical curve;

170 feet Northerly from 8th Street, 776.49;

220 feet Northerly from 8th Street, 776.41 the end of said  
vertical curve;

At South line of 9th Street, 775.95;

East side of Olive Street:

At North line of 8th Street, 774.10;

120 feet Northerly from 8th Street, 775.20 a point of beginning  
of a vertical curve;

170 feet Northerly from 8th Street, 775.49;

220 feet Northerly from 8th Street, 775.41 the end of said  
vertical curve;

At South line of 9th Street, 774.95.

Section 3. The elevations of all grades, where not otherwise specified, are given herein at the top of the street edge of the curb, and the property line elevation can be ascertained by computing same on the width of the sidewalk. All sidewalks on Olive Street shall slope upward and away from the curb to the property line at the rate of one quarter inch to the foot, and all sidewalks shall be twelve (12) feet wide except that on the West side of Olive Street between Pacific Avenue and a point eighty (80) feet North of Eleventh Street the curb shall be built sixteen (16) feet from the property line and the five (5) foot concrete sidewalk shall be built adjacent to the curb and shall slope upward from the top of the curb at the rate of one-quarter inch to the foot.

The curb grades between any grade established herein and the next nearest grade point in the same block on the same side of the street shall be a direct line between such points, except as herein designated as following the line of a vertical curve, in which case it shall follow said curve.

The elevations of grades hereby established are given in feet and decimals of a foot. The figures following the designation of grade points indicate the number of feet that such points are above sea level, and are fixed and established with reference to a common datum plane and standard bench mark consisting of the top of a brass bolt set in the nosing of the cast iron sill at the Northeast corner of Twelfth and Spring Streets in said City, the said datum plane and standard bench mark being at the elevation of 738.60 feet above sea level.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.


