

ORDINANCE NO. 456 N.S.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A BRIDGE DEVELOPMENT FEE
FOR THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles does ordain as follows:


- 12.19.010 The chapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Bridge Development Fee Ordinance".
- 12.19.020 Purpose. The purpose of this chapter is to assess fees to all developments in the city on a per acre basis, to be used for bridge or bridges which are determined by the City Council as necessary for City-wide circulation.
- 12.19.030 The City Council may, from time to time, by resolution, issue regulation and set fees for implementation of the Chapter.
- 12.19.040 Policy. The City of El Paso de Robles does hereby officially establish the following policy in regard to bridge development fees.
1. Policy. All recent Environmental Impact Reports have indicated traffic and general circulation problems and specifically cited the need for additional river crossings. Bridge development is generally to benefit all citizens of Paso Robles and as such, new development within the city should share in a portion of bridge costs on a per acre basis.
 2. Bridge development generally benefits non-residential land to a greater extent than residential land and consequently shall have a higher fee.
- 12.19.050 Fee Required. When fees are required by resolution of the City Council, such payments shall be made at the time of request for a building permit.
- 12.19.060 Account. Fees received pursuant to this Chapter shall be paid to a Bridge Development Fund and used exclusively for Bridge Development including costs necessary for preparation, construction and maintenance of bridges.


