

ORDINANCE NO. 555 N. S.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PASO ROBLES
 ADDING CHAPTER 9.41, SMOKING PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN AREAS,
 TO THE PASO ROBLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Paso Robles as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 9.41, Smoking Prohibited in Certain Areas is hereby added to read as follows:

CHAPTER 9.41
 SMOKING PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN AREAS

- 9.41.020 Prohibition in Certain Public Meeting Facilities.
- 9.41.030 Posting of Signs.

9.41.010 PURPOSE.

Because smoking is a positive danger to health and a cause of material discomfort and a health hazard to those who are present in confined places, and in order to serve public health, safety and welfare, the declared purpose of this chapter is to prohibit smoking in certain areas which are used by or open to the public.

9.41.020 PROHIBITION IN CERTAIN PUBLIC MEETING FACILITIES.

Smoking shall be prohibited in City-owned, leased or operated public meeting facilities, including the City Council Chambers.

The City Council, at its discretion, may designate a smoking area in such meeting facilities.

9.41.030 POSTING OF SIGNS

Signs which designate smoking or no-smoking areas established by this chapter shall be conspicuously posted in every public meeting room covered by this chapter.

9.41.040 COMPLIANCE

The City Manager or his designated representative shall be responsible for compliance with this chapter.

9.41.050 VIOLATION - PENALTY

Any person who violates any provision of Section 9.41.020 by smoking in a posted "No Smoking" area is guilty of an infraction, and is subject to punishment as provided for in the Municipal Code.
