ORDINANCE NO. 574 N.S.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
 REPEALING SECTIONS 9, 10 AND 11 OF ORDINANCE 266 N.S. AND
 ADDING CHAPTER 1.02 TO THE PASO ROBLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Sections 9, 10 and 11 of Ordinance 266 N.S. (1963) series are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. There is hereby added to the Municipal Code of the City of El Paso de Robles Chapter 1.02, which is to read as follows:

CHAPTER 1.02PENALTIES

Section 1.02.010: Violations: Misdemeanor and Infractions. It shall be unlawful for any person to violate any provision or to fail to comply with any of the requirements of this Code. A violation of any of the provisions or a failure to comply with any of the requirements shall constitute a misdemeanor except for those specifically declared by this Code to be an infraction. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code, any misdemeanor violation or failure to comply may, in the discretion of the City Attorney, be initially charged or subsequently prosecuted as an infraction. Each and every infraction violation is punishable by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for a first violation; a fine not exceeding Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for a second violation of the same ordinance within one year; and a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for a third violation of the same ordinance within one year. Each and every misdemeanor violation is punishable by a fine not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00), or by imprisonment in the County jail for a period not exceeding six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Each person shall be guilty of a separate offense for each and every day during any portion of which any violation of any provisions of this Code is committed, continued, or permitted by such person and shall be punishable accordingly.

Section 1.02.020. Violations Include Aiding, Abetting, Concealing. Every person who causes, aids, abets, or conceals the fact of a violation of this Code is guilty of violating this Code.

Section 1.02.030. Enforcement by Civil Action for Nuisance. In addition to the penalties hereinabove provided, any condition caused or permitted to exist in violation of any of the provisions of this Code shall be deemed a public nuisance and may be, by this City, summarily abated as such, and every day such condition continues shall be regarded as a new and separate offense.
