

ORDINANCE NO. 689 N.S.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES  
 AMENDING CHAPTER 12 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROHIBIT  
 ROLLER SKATING, SKATEBOARDING OR RIDING IN OR BY MEANS  
 OF COASTING IN ALL COMMERCIAL ZONING DISTRICTS  
 (CITY OF PASO ROBLES)

WHEREAS, the City of Paso Robles has initiated Code Amendment 95002 to prohibit roller skating, skateboarding or riding in or by means of coasting in all commercial zones, and

WHEREAS, the City has commercial shopping centers in the C-1, C-2, C-3, Neighborhood Commercial (CP) and Regional Commercial (RC) zoning districts, and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code currently prohibits roller skating, skateboarding or riding in or by means of coasting, in the C-1 Zone only, and

WHEREAS, the intent of this code amendment is to allow the Paso Robles Police Department to enforce the prohibition of roller skating, roller blading, skateboarding and by other means of coasting within all commercial zoning districts, and

WHEREAS, public hearings were conducted by the City Council on March 7, and April 4, 1995, to consider facts as presented in the staff report and to accept public testimony regarding this proposed code amendment, and

WHEREAS, staff has determined that this code amendment is exempt from environmental review in accordance with Section 15061(b)(3) of the California Environmental Quality Act, and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of April 4, 1995, the City Council gave first reading to this ordinance, and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of April 18, 1995, the City Council gave second reading to this ordinance, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT KNOWN that the Paso Robles City Council, based upon the substantial evidence presented at the above referenced public hearing, including oral and written staff reports, finds as follows:

1. The above stated facts of this ordinance are true and correct.
2. This code amendment is consistent with the General Plan.
3. This code amendment is not in conflict with the State Motor Vehicle Code or any other vehicle codes adopted by the City of Paso Robles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, that the Paso Robles Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT KNOWN that the Paso Robles City Council, based upon the substantial evidence presented at the above referenced public hearing, including oral and written staff reports, finds as follows:

1. The above stated facts of this ordinance are true and correct.
2. This code amendment is consistent with the General Plan.
3. This code amendment is not in conflict with the State Motor Vehicle Code or any other vehicle codes adopted by the City of Paso Robles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, that the Paso Robles Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION I:** Chapter 12.24.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.24.030 Vehicles not to be driven on sidewalks.

The driver of any bicycle or other similar device shall not drive within any sidewalk area or any parkway except at a permanent or temporary driveway. It is unlawful for any person to go upon any sidewalk in any commercial zoning districts, according to the latest adopted zoning map, upon roller skates, skateboards or riding in or by means of any coaster.
