

ORDINANCE NO. 692 N.S.

CODE AMENDMENT 95005 OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
 AMENDING CHAPTER 12 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC)
 TO PROHIBIT ROLLER SKATING, SKATEBOARDING OR RIDING IN OR BY MEANS
 OF COASTING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY AND PROPERTY OPEN TO THE PUBLIC
 (CITY OF PASO ROBLES)

WHEREAS, the City of Paso Robles has initiated Code Amendment 95005 to further clarify where roller skating, skateboarding or riding in or by means of coasting should be prohibited, and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code currently prohibits roller skating, skateboarding or riding in or by means of coasting in all commercial zoning districts, and

WHEREAS, the intent of this code amendment is to allow the Paso Robles Police Department to enforce the prohibition of roller skating, roller blading, skateboarding and by other means of coasting on private property if properly posted by the property owner, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted by the City Council on July 18, 1995, to consider facts as presented in the staff report and to accept public testimony regarding this proposed code amendment, and

WHEREAS, staff has determined that this code amendment is exempt from environmental review in accordance with Section 15061(b)(3) of the California Environmental Quality Act, and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of July 18, 1995, the City Council gave first reading to this ordinance, and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of August 1, 1995, the City Council gave second reading to this ordinance, and

WHEREAS, this ordinance shall go into effect on August 31, 1995.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT KNOWN that the Paso Robles City Council, based upon the substantial evidence presented at the above referenced public hearing, including oral and written staff reports, finds as follows:

1. The above stated facts of this ordinance are true and correct.
2. This code amendment is consistent with the General Plan.
3. This code amendment is not in conflict with the State Motor Vehicle Code or any other vehicle codes adopted by the City of Paso Robles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, that the Paso Robles Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION I: Chapter 12.24.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.24.030 Vehicles not to be driven on sidewalks and posted properties.

The driver of any bicycle or other similar device shall not drive within any sidewalk area or any parkway except at a permanent or temporary driveway. It is unlawful for any person to go upon any sidewalk in any commercial zoning districts, according to the latest adopted zoning map, upon roller skates, skateboards or riding in or by means of any coaster.

Further, it shall be unlawful for any person to go onto any private property or property open to the public upon roller skates, skateboards or riding in or by means of any coaster under the following circumstances: There is displayed, in plain view, at all entrances to the property, a sign not less than 17 by 22 inches in size, with lettering not less than one inch in height, prohibiting riding upon roller skates, skateboards or riding in or by means of any coaster. The posted sign shall include the appropriate City of Paso Robles Ordinance number.
