

## ORDINANCE NO. 700 N.S.

CODE AMENDMENT 95007 OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES  
 AMENDING CHAPTER 21.16A OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE  
 (PLANNED DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT)  
 TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FLEXIBILITY IN MODIFYING  
 THE WIDTH AND LOCATION OF SIDEWALKS AND/OR PARKWAYS  
 (CITY INITIATED)

WHEREAS, the City of Paso Robles has initiated Code Amendment 95007 to consider adding additional flexibility to the application of the Planned Development District provisions, and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code currently prohibits the Planning Commission or City Council from making modifications to the location and/or width of sidewalks and/or parkways through the use of the Planned Development process, and

WHEREAS, the intent of this code amendment is to allow the Planning Commission or City Council, subject to making the required findings pursuant to Section 21.16A of the Zoning Code, to consider and make modifications to the location/width of sidewalks and/or parkways, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was conducted by the City Council on November 7, 1995, to consider facts as presented in the staff report and to accept public testimony regarding this proposed code amendment, and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of November 7, 1995, the City Council gave first reading to this ordinance, and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of November 21, 1995, the City Council gave second reading to this ordinance, and

WHEREAS, this ordinance shall go into effect on December 21, 1995.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT KNOWN that the Paso Robles City Council, based upon the substantial evidence presented at the above referenced public hearing, including oral and written staff reports, finds as follows:

1. The above stated facts of this ordinance are true and correct.
2. This code amendment is not inconsistent with the General Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, California, that the Paso Robles Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION I:** Chapter 21.16A.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(11) Cannot be used to modify safety requirements for public improvements such as engineered street and driveway design or street widths;

(12) Can be used to provide flexibility to modify other public improvements, such as the width and location of parkways and sidewalks when such modifications do not adversely affect public safety;

(13) Cannot be used to modify the standards of the sign ordinance."
