

ORDINANCE NO. 715 N.S.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES
 AMENDING CHAPTER 3.40 REVENUE AND FINANCE
 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADOPT FISCAL YEAR 1996/97 BUDGET
 FOR THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF EL PASO DE ROBLES

The City Council of the City of El Paso de Robles, State of California, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1.

That the budget for the Redevelopment Agency of the City of El Paso de Robles for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1996 and ending June 30, 1997 as prepared and submitted by the Redevelopment Manager and reviewed by the Agency Secretary, is hereby approved and adopted as the budget of the Agency for said fiscal year (hereinafter "budget"). Said budget is identified as Attachment "A" and is incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2.

That from the effective date of said budget, to wit: July 1, 1992, the several amounts stated therein as proposed expenditures shall be and become appropriated to the Agency for the respective objects and purposes therein set forth, subject to expenditures pursuant to the provisions of all applicable statutes of this State.

SECTION 3.

That the Secretary to the RDA shall have the authority to incur obligations and enter into contracts not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) without prior approval of the Agency and shall follow the City's purchasing ordinance.

SECTION 4.

That the Agency hereby finds and determines:

a) That all of the expenditures and appropriations pursuant to the budget are for Redevelopment activities consistent with California Health and Safety Code 33678 in that they are for carrying out the Redevelopment Project and related development activities, as defined in California Health and Safety Sections 33020 and 33021, and primarily benefit the Redevelopment Project.

b) That none of the funds are to be used for the purposes of paying for employee or for contractual services for the City of El Paso de Robles or any other local government agency, except for such services which are directly related to Redevelopment activities as defined in California Health and Safety Code Sections 33020 and 33021 and the powers established in Community Redevelopment Law.

SECTION 5.

That the appropriation and expenditure of funds shall be consistent with the terms as established by cooperative agreement between the Redevelopment Agency of the City of El Paso de Robles and the City of El Paso de Robles per Agency and City adopting implementing resolutions.
