
Meeting in the Park Follow Up

Thank you for attending the August 29 Meeting in the Park, where we discussed the transitions surrounding Larry Moore Park. We realize that the park is a special part of your community, and we are grateful to have had the opportunity to begin a discussion with you about potential changes. The purpose of this email is to follow up on several questions that arose during the meeting, and provide you with additional information and updates.

Due to low landscape maintenance assessment rates in the Riverbank Subdivision, Larry Moore Park maintenance has been grossly underfunded. The City has decided to assume maintenance of Larry Moore Park due to the inadequate assessments, continued complaints and concerns regarding the park's quality and safety.

This gave rise to the question: If a majority of the Riverbank Subdivision votes to increase their assessment to the necessary rate of \$455/year per parcel that is required to maintain the park, could the park remain as is and under Riverbank's responsibility?

While increasing the assessment would improve the park's condition, it would not alter its function as a public park. Therefore, the responsibility for its improvement and maintenance will rest with the City as with other public parks.

The August 29 meeting marked the beginning of the discussion with the neighborhood. More input is needed, and we will continue to consider input as plans move forward.

Some concerns expressed at the meeting included accommodating additional parking, installing a new traffic light at the neighborhood entryways or traffic calming along Riverbank Lane, user safety, and the introduction of lighted fields. The City will review the propriety and feasibility of these items.

An additional workshop date has been tentatively set for Saturday, December 12 to share a park upgrade concept.
