# Drought Response: 2016 Update

## Conservation and Outlook

- January water conservation fell short of State mandate for the month (17% from target)
- City has achieved mandated conservation for the June 2015 – February 2016 period.
- Significant opportunities to reduce water use in the community:
  - Turn off irrigation during the winter
  - Comply with watering schedule & other mandatory restrictions
  - Do not water during or within 48-hours of rain
  - Check for leaks indoors & outdoors, and fix immediately

# Drought Response: 2016 Update

## Extension of State Emergency Regulation

- Recovering from current drought will take multiple years of above-average snow and rainfall
- State proposes to extend emergency water conservation regulations to include March 1<sup>st</sup> through Oct 31<sup>st</sup>, 2016
- The City's conservation standard for this period is expected to be 24% (relative to same months in 2013)
- City's current Level 2 Mandatory Reductions will remain in effect to assist the community in maintaining sufficient conservation and complying with the extended conservation regulations
