City of Paso Robles Looking for Volunteers to Serve on the City Manager's Task Force on Medical Marijuana

The City of Paso Robles is in the process of forming a community Task Force on Medical Marijuana. This five- to seven-member Task Force, intended to represent all perspectives, will consider options to regulate medical marijuana in the following key areas, among others:

- Personal medical cultivation, both indoors and outdoors
- Mobile medical dispensaries
- Brick and mortar medical dispensaries
- Licensing, inspections, and fees related to medical marijuana

The goal is to craft recommendations to the City Council that will best serve the entire Paso Robles community going forward.
