Library Introduces Two New Teen Volunteer Programs

PASO ROBLES, CA – The Paso Robles City Library is pleased to announce the establishment of two new volunteer programs designed to help meet the community service needs of area students, grades 9-12.

The **Express Program** will be offered for one week during the Winter Break (Tuesday, January 2 through Saturday, January 6, 2018), and Spring break (dates TBA). Shifts are 2-3 hours per day; students may work a maximum of 15 hours. Duties include cleaning and shelving/shelf reading.

The **Ongoing Program** will be offered each school semester: January-May and August-December. Shifts are 2-3 hours per day; students must work a minimum of 20 hours per semester. Duties may include:

- Assisting at public desks
- Assisting with programs
- Shelving/shelf reading
- Cleaning/dusting shelves
