VOTING PROCEDURE

Each Councilmember will complete a ranking sheet following each interview. Councilmembers will deliberate, and the Mayor will ask for motions to nominate applicants to fill the vacancies. Council will vote and the Mayor will announce the names of those appointed to the Youth Commission.
