Drought Response: 2015 Update

Conservation Rebates

- Record high enrollment has exceeded expectations. 100,330 sqft. have been converted in the past 4 months.
- Currently \$102,600 committed to active rebates (98% of allocated budget). Uncommitted rebate budget projected to be committed this month
- \$24 million state rebate program was announced Aug. 12th (up to \$2/ sqft. of turf, \$2,000 per property; up to \$100 per toilet)
- State program allows concurrent enrollment w/ local agency rebates (state would provide the difference between local agency rebate and state maximum of \$2/sqft.)
- Council may consider further revision to base annual rebate allocations to allow rebate participation in current FY and/ or future drought years through the budget process

Drought Response: 2015 Update

Enforcement

- PT staff members continue to patrol, perform rebate enrollment, and assist customers with high usage, timers, etc.
- Blue Tag Notices Issued
 - August 1 – 15th: 2 (was 4 in last report)
- Violation Notices Issued
 - August 1 – 15th: 32 (was 41 in last report)
