Some classes remain outside opting to soak in the spring sunshine at Centennial Park. A few classes are being offered virtually as well. Below are some April class highlights along with a look ahead to summer swim lesson and youth activity registration beginning Saturday, May 1 at the **Summer Fun Sign-Up Day**.

Art Park: Our new class series for young artists continues at Centennial Park as instructor Mindy Dierks will add **Let's Learn About Color** this month. During this six week series, students will learn how to create colors by mixing, exploring color interactions and discovering how to blend color to create beautiful pieces of art. Various painting styles including pointillism, brush strokes, cubism and more will be explored. Art Park's popular **Let's Begin with Drawing** class will begin a new series this month featuring different weekly projects around the common theme that shapes are in everything we see. **Let's Learn About Color:** Tuesdays, April 13-May 18 from 3:15-5:15 p.m. (ages 5-6) and Wednesdays, April 14-May 19 from 3:15-5:15 p.m. (ages 7-8), \$115 (includes all materials). **Let's Begin with Drawing:** Thursdays, April 15-May 20 from 1:15-3:15 p.m. (ages 5-6) and 3:45-5:45 p.m. (ages 7-8), \$100 (includes all materials).

Youth Evolution Basketball: Help your child stay active during these weekly skill-based basketball classes that also focus on respect, teamwork and responsibility. Five week session, each Tuesday April 20-May 18 on the Centennial Park basketball courts. Creative Me Time: Mini Mosaics Craft at Home Kit: Create a fun mini masterpiece while learning mosaic basics during this beginner class that you can do from the comfort and safety of your own home. Each kit includes supplies to make a 4" square mosaic in a heart or flower design. Also included is an instruction sheet and link to a how-to video to guide crafters through the process from start to finish. \$10 registration fee (payable online) + \$15 supply fee (payable at pick-up). Kits are available for curbside pick-up in the Centennial Park parking lot on Monday, April 19 from 6-7 p.m. (advance registration required). Ages 10 to adult.
